B. COURSE DESCRIPTION & OBJECTIVES:

Advanced Accounting will present concepts and methods for business combinations, partnership formation and dissolution, governmental and non-profit accounting.

The concepts you learn in this class will build from experiences you have had in other accounting disciplines. However, a new world will be opened in Advanced Accounting. This class will allow you to expand your level of thinking and understanding of the importance of accounting and the opportunities for employment in this area. Your ability to solve problems and think individually and collectively will drive the focus of this course. The text will serve as a reference to many of our discussions but will not be the only focus of class.

You will be expected to work in groups as well as individually. You will be called upon to present certain topics and problems. Normally you will be given advance notice, but on occasion spur of the moment callings may be issued to report on a particular homework assignment or issue from the text.

While you can't learn in a classroom setting how to deal with every situation that may arise in the business world, the theory can be learned such that you can work individually or in a group to accomplish the task at hand. Step 1 and Step 2 may not work in every situation nor in that order. The focus will be on the theory and the big picture so that for each specific situation you face you will have the knowledge and work ethic to work through to a solution.

Class periods will be devoted to introductory lectures of new material, review of assignments, chapter quizzes and segment exams.

C. SPECIAL NEEDS:

D. EXAMS AND QUIZZES:

Students will be given 10% of grade based on homework completion and participation. Participation points are received from being on time, attendance to class, and general participation in class. Homework points are received from timely submission of completed homework. Emphasis on homework is placed on effort, not correctness. **There will be no extra credit available.**

There is a zero-tolerance policy for cheating and dishonesty. A student caught cheating on a quiz or test will receive an automatic zero on that particular assignment. If the same student cheats a second time, he/she will be asked to leave class and an appropriate action will be taken (according to Dixie State College Policy).
